Highlights

- Benchmark-aware strategy targeting a wide spectrum of securitized assets, including agency mortgage-backed securities (agency MBS) as well as investment grade asset-backed securities (ABS), collateralized loan obligation securities (CLO), commercial mortgage-backed securities (CMBS) and non-agency residential mortgage-backed securities (non-agency RMBS)
- Investment style combines a top-down approach to inter-sector allocation decisions and an active bottom-up security selection framework
- Investment strategy based on proprietary prepayment and credit research
- May only buy securities rated investment grade at the time of purchase
- Duration is typically managed +/- 1.5 years of benchmark duration
- Utilizes To-Be-Announced (TBA) securities
- No limit to out-of-benchmark allocations
- US dollar-denominated securities only

The Composite includes all discretionary accounts with market values of at least \$25 million managed by Loomis Sayles with guidelines that allow for investing in securities that must be rated investment grade at time of purchase and with 80% of the portfolio typically invested in securitized assets, such as mortgage- and other asset-backed securities. The Composite seeks a high level of current income consistent with capital preservation through diversified exposure to Agency MBS, CMBS and ABS. The Composite inception date is May 1, 2006.
